Day 1 Coverage Report

TVET Sector Support Programme organized a Media Exposure Visit of the Technical Training Centres in Balochistan. A group of senior journalists from leading media outlets was invited to tour the facilities of the learning environment and observe how appropriate and demand-driven training is provided to Baloch youth of both genders.

They visited both the Women Technical Training Center (WTTTC) and the Boys Technical Training Center (BTTC) where a total of, 120 students (male and female) are enrolled in various training courses in the projects supported through the training fund initiative of TVET Sector Support Programme. The programme is working with NAVTTTC, provincial TEVTAs and PVTTC since 2011 for bringing reforms in TVET Sector. Journalists also had one-on-one interaction sessions with the trainees to comprehend their firsthand experiences.

They recognized the impact of the TVET Sector Support Programme which is being funded by the European Union, the Federal Republic of Germany, and the Royal Norwegian Embassy, commissioned by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), and is being implemented by the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) in improving employment opportunities for the youth of Balochistan

Day 2 Coverage Report

TVET Sector Support Programme is working with Government and Private Enterprises in generating employment opportunities for the youth of Balochistan. In the second phase of its implementation, the programme is supporting competency-based training of 36,800 men and women in indigenous and industry-demand-driven trades. The Programme is funded by the European Union, the Federal Republic of Germany, and the Royal Norwegian Embassy, commissioned by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), and is being implemented by the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ).

The TVET Sector Support Programme arranged a media visit to the Balochistan Women Business Association (BWBA), Quetta. The institute is playing its role in empowering women entrepreneurs in setting up their businesses and starting work in the formal sector in recent times. TVET Sector Support Programme engages by implementing partners to draw agreements with enterprises for labour demand, input in curriculum, provision of on-the-job training placements, and also assessment of trainees as per NVQF standards. So far, the programme has supported more than 1,300 such agreements across Pakistan.

The media delegation visited an Institute Partner Organization of the IDO - Balochistan Marble Pvt. Limited from where good feedback is received. While speaking to the on-job trainees, a batch of 20 young boys shared with media representatives that their experience has been excellent at the workplace-based learning site.

The programme is being implemented by GIZ Pakistan and NAVTTC, which is being funded by the European Union and the governments of the Federal Republic of Germany and Norway. A group of senior journalists from leading media outlets was invited to tour the facilities and to get a first-hand experience of the learning environment of a Technical Training Centre that uses the **Workplace-Based Training (WBT)** approach to develop skilled human resource in-line with market demands and increasing graduates' chances of getting more employment opportunities. When the media delegates arrived at the institute, the Principal of the Women's Technical Training Centre (WTTTC) held a briefing session to provide a detailed overview of the institute's working progress and in-house training facilities provided by TVET Sector Support Programme. Following the introduction, the media team was escorted to the technical training laboratories and other facilities in the institute, where they had one-on-one interaction sessions with trainers to discuss their learning experiences. WTTTC offers training for the occupations of Computer Operator, Office Assistant, and

Cook, Boys Technical Training Center (BTTC) is preparing skilled labourers such as Computer Operators, HV AC Technicians, and Auto Electricians. A total of 120 students (male and female) are enrolled in various training courses in

Health Dept formulated contingency plan in view of expected arrival of Afghan refugees in Balochistan: Dr. Rubaba

Quetta (APP) Parliamentary Secretary for Health Dr. Rubaba Khan Baluch on Wednesday said the Health Department has formulated a contingency plan in view of the expected arrival of Afghan refugees in Balochistan. She said the changing situation in neighbouring Afghanistan has potential for Afghan refugees to arrive in Balochistan which could increase the pressure on the available system of health.

"The Balochistan Health Department has formulated a contingency plan in view of the expected arrival of about 80,000 Afghan refugees," she noted. The Parliamentary Secretary for Health expressed these views while addressing a special guest at a seminar organized in connection with the transport function of the Nutrition Response Project for COVID-19 and Cholera-affected children under five years of age organized by consortium of Balochistan Rural Support Program (BRSP) and Government of Balochistan, Director General Health Services, Dr. Aftab Nazir.

BRSP Head, Nadeem Gul Bhattachi, Director Nutrition Dr. Akmal Feroz, Manager Nutrition International Shaheed Akbar Khan Manager Health Nutrition BRSP Saigal Haq (Gharat), Dr. Iqbal Mirza and other concerned officials were present on the occasion. Parliamentary Health Secretary Dr. Rubaba Khan Baluch said the problem of malnutrition among children and mothers in different districts of the province were very serious in view of which a nutrition emergency has been imposed in Balochistan from 2019.

"It is possible to achieve positive results," Pakistan's first Nutrition Directorate has been set up in Quetta to bring all the nutrition programs under one roof," she underlined. She said all available resources were being utilized as only a healthy mother and a healthy child are the guarantee of a bright future.

"Balochistan Rural Support Program (BRSP) launched nutrition programs for children suffering from COVID-19 in five districts of Balochistan which is positive steps

During a recent media visit arranged by the TVET Sector Support Programme, Sana Durrani, the Chairperson of the BWBA headed the attending media persons at the facility on the first floor approximately 5,000 skilled women are registered in the BWBA and working in three major sectors of Livestock, Agriculture and Handicrafts comprising of Local Entrepreneurs.

She praised the partnership of the TVET Sector Support Programme for providing Technical and Vocational Education and Training and helping the BWBA to train 100 skilled women in business trades to establish teaching units or to start a small business for them.

He said the TVET training covers jobs an important role in the economic prosperity of Balochistan's women saying it was thus imperative to the backbone of the economic development of this region, but there is more to be done in TVET and Private Sector's engagement to achieve desirable results.

The second phase of programme has funding of 62.5 million. After the implementation of reforms in the TVET sector of Pakistan on

national, provincial and regional level, he mentioned adding the Programme was funded by the European Union, Federal Republic of Germany and the Royal Norwegian Embassy. He said in second phase of its implementation, programme was supporting competency-based training of 30,800 men and women on the industry and industry-demand-driven trades.

Faisal Ehsan said the Programme has been commissioned by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and is being implemented by the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH, funded by the European Union, Norwegian and German Governments. He said the TVET Sector Support Programme has been involved in promoting multiple private partnerships, among they have facilitated Institute Partner Organization (IPO) in setting 8 MoUs with different enterprises.

Partnering institutes of TVET Sector Support Programme regularly coordinate with private sector for training methodology improvement and learner job placement, he said. He said the practical orientation of the media delegation was evident when they visited a private garment organization of DDO, Balochistan Market Pkt Limited from where a good feedback is received.

While speaking to the on-job trainees, a batch of 20 young boys shared with media representatives that their on-job experience has been excellent at the workplace-based learning site and that most of them already had the job offers, he mentioned adding similarly, job placements (16) each in Zinda Market, Gadh Marble, and Khan Market show the success of the ongoing TVET Sector Support Programme.

He said to promote the private sector engagement in TVET sector, TVET Sector Support Programme engages implementing partners to enter agreement with enterprises for sector demand. Input in curriculum, governance and participation in monitoring, management, provide on-the-job training, placements and also source trainees per NVQF.
