## INTRODUCTION

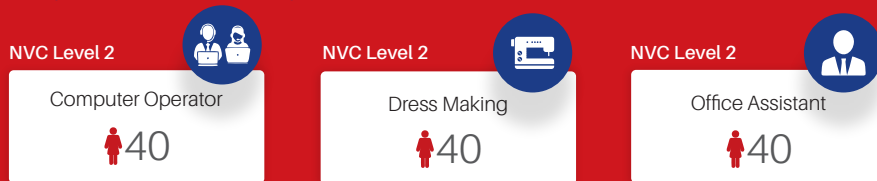
