## Skill Development **Project on Information Technology**

## **OBJECTIVES**

The project 'Skill Development Project on Information Technology' was designed to improve youth employability through soft skills acquisition using information technology, & management sciences. To impart workplace-based training to 160 trainees (80 men and 80 women) jointly with the partnering enterprises, the project carried out training activities for 26-months. The training intervention enabled enrolled trainees to learn technical skills leading to employment in the information technology and graphic designing related occupations.

approaches in training delivery, which meet the demands of the involved enterprises.




## **NUMBER OF TRAINEES (MEN AND WOMEN)**
