









INTRODUCTION

The TVET Sector Support Programme promotes an active partnership between training (TVET) institutes and private sector for imparting industry demand-driven training. The workplace-based training approach provides trained human resource to the employers according to their need, thus, increasing the chances of employments of graduates. The involved enterprises and business industry associations are engaged in selecting relevant qualifications, planning and delivering training, and conducting assessments within the national qualification framework of Pakistan.

The Programme provides technical support to training institutes and enterprises to link theoretical with practical training at the workplace. In this regard, both sides can agree on flexible approaches in training delivery, which enterprises.

This project was designed to facilitate provision of demand-driven skills for 550 trainees (327 women and 223 men) in collaboration with partnering enterprises, leading to employment (self-employment included). Further, to strengthen the engagement of private sector enterprises in training design, coordination and delivery partnership with private sector were enhanced. Also, the project trainees and graduates acted as a training-cum production centre for development of 50,000 PPE kits, 40,000 surgical masks and 15,000 fabric masks (all produced by the graduates and handed over to the provincial health authorities to deal with COVID 19)
